

Anna Carabelli. Full professor of Political Economy at the Università degli Studi del Piemonte Orientale, Italy. She graduated from Bocconi University in Milan and took her PhD at the University of Cambridge. Her research interests are in the field of methodology, epistemology, history of economic thought, philosophy of measurement with particular reference to Keynes, Hayek and Sraffa. Other research interests are in the field of happiness and material conditions, and of international monetary relations (the morality of debt, international reserves, 'policy space', Bretton Woods² and Washington consensus). She is the author of *On Keynes's Method* (Macmillan 1988), of articles on Keynes's probability and uncertainty, on the comparison between Keynes and Hayek's views on expectations, and on Keynes's methodological relevance today (*Journal of Post-Keynesian Economics*, *Journal of Economic Issues*, *Forum for Social Sciences*, *Intervention*, *European Journal of Economics and Economic Policies*, *European Planning Studies*, *European Journal for the History of Economic Thought*, *Cambridge Journal of Economics*).
