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My research focuses on the study of social inequalities, addressed as a structural and symbolic dimension of collective life. Along the vectors of class, gender, territory and generation, I have analysed how inequalities are reproduced, transformed and perceived, with particular attention to the trajectories of transition to adulthood, territorial divisions in access to education and work, and the effects of neoliberal rationalisation on individual biographies. This analytical framework is supported by a strong focus on research methodology, understood not only as a technical tool but also as an epistemological device. The use of advanced quantitative tools – from event history analysis to sequential analysis – has been accompanied by the design of surveys and participation in public policy evaluations, often in dialogue with institutional and territorial actors. Within this framework, I have reflected on gender as a principle of differentiation and inequality, investigating it in various contexts. From the political representation of women in municipal councils and boards of directors to the dynamics of segregation in medical specialisation pathways, my studies have critically examined the relationship between formal norms, persistent stereotypes and structural gaps.

The field of education is another privileged observatory, where inequalities are produced and/or neutralised. I have investigated the conditions of university dropout, declining confidence in educational credentials, transformations in teaching during the pandemic and forms of school governance, with a focus on the mechanisms of stratification implicit in educational processes.

In recent years, this focus has extended to the relationship between health, adolescence, and education, particularly in the analysis of youth narratives during Covid-19, mental health in school-age children, and gender inequalities in the medical professions. Here, health emerges as a social device that reflects and intensifies social asymmetries.

Finally, the study of public policies – from local welfare to the digitisation of schools, from anti-poverty plans to the evaluation of social interventions – has allowed me to observe how institutions produce, administer and sometimes amplify inequalities. The analysis of territorial governance and decision-making processes has been intertwined with empirical research on policy mechanisms, in dialogue with local actors, research institutions and public administrations.
