#### **CURRENT ISSUES OF RESEARCH**

##### **1. Monastic Archaeology in the Middle Ages**

The research is focused on the Early Middle Ages and central Middle Ages monasteries, in relation to the study, through written and material sources, of material structures,

topography, relationships with the territory and settlement, inclusion in the routes system and in the pilgrimage networks, construction of the ownerships.

## **2. Hospitality in the Early Middle Ages**

The research deals with the hospitality and its different shapes during the post-classical Age, notably in relation to the material evidence of the reception, by means of both written and archaeological sources and in a diachronic perspective.

## **3. Early Medieval Sculpture**

The research concentrates on sculptural artefacts, belonging to liturgical furniture and architectural ornamentation of religious buildings. These are investigated from the perspective of a chrono-typological contextualization, of the production and patronage issues, as well as in relation to functional aspects, linked to the uses of liturgical furniture as means of definition and organisation of the ecclesiastic spaces.

## **4. Pilgrimage and relics between Late Antiquity and Early Middle Ages**

The research focuses on both specific contexts in Northern Italy (notably the monastery of Bobbio, Piacenza) as well as general aspects, linked to the devotional journey and cult of relics. This subject is studied especially in relation to its impact on the organisation of the liturgical and sacred space.

## **5. Religious organisation and settlement between Late Antiquity and Middle Ages**

The research focuses on settlement pattern problems, with specific attention to ecclesiastic organisation and fortifications as centres of shaping landscapes, from a diachronic perspective.
