Federica Vigna-Taglianti is Associate Professor of Public Health and Epidemiology at University of Eastern Piedmont. Until 2021 she held the same position at University of Torino. For many years she collaborated with the Piedmont Centre for Drug Addiction Epidemiology in North-West of Italy. She participated to the study design, conduction, statistical analysis and results dissemination of several European Studies: GENAIR, a trans-national cohort study for the evaluation of relationship between environmental pollutants and lung cancer; HYENA, a trans-national cross-sectional study on exposure to noise and hypertension; EU-Dap, a cluster randomized trial conducted in 7 European countries for the evaluation of effectiveness of the school-based program Unplugged in preventing tobacco, alcohol and substance use among adolescents; EU-Dap2, a project involving 9 European countries for the dissemination, monitoring and impact evaluation of the Unplugged prevention program; and LIFE PATH, a trans-national Horizon 2020 project involving 15 institutions in Europe, the US and Australia, investigating the links between socioeconomic factors and age-related health outcomes. She also coordinated the evaluation of effectiveness of the Unplugged prevention program in several replication trials, the most recent in Nigeria on behalf of UNODC.

At the national Italian level, she participated to the conduction and evaluation of the VEdTTE and VOECT cohorts of heroin, cocaine and alcohol dependents treated in NHS addiction services and Therapeutic Communities, and to a cohort study evaluating the mortality and comorbidity of psychotic patients of the city of Torino. She is currently conducting a cohort study evaluating the excess and risk factors for general and cause-specific mortality and covid infection among mental health patients.

Her research interests concern the evaluation of effectiveness of treatments and prevention interventions for tobacco, alcohol and drug addiction and abuse, with specific focus on adolescent health, gender differences and health inequalities. Currently, she is conducting a cohort study evaluating the excess and risk factors for general and cause-specific mortality and covid infection among mental health patients. She has conducted several systematic reviews on behalf of the Cochrane Collaboration Drugs and Alcohol Group.

She published more than 65 papers in international journals, and she presented results of research in many national and international conferences.
