A unifying thread connects my work: understanding how humans construct meaning, interpret others' minds, cope with vulnerability, and develop cognitive and social strategies shaping both individual and collective life.

Emiliano Loria is a philosopher and researcher whose work brings together philosophy of mind, developmental psychology, and the philosophy of psychiatry. After completing his PhD within the FINO Consortium, he continued his academic career as adjunct lecturer in Philosophy of Mind and as a collaborator in observational research projects in psychiatry carried out in partnership with Sapienza University of Rome. He is also part of the Aging Project at the University of Eastern Piedmont, where he develops interdisciplinary reflections on vulnerability, mental health, and social transformations.

Author of essays and monographs, he has explored topics ranging from mindreading and natural pedagogy to the analysis of contemporary social phenomena, such as conspiracy thinking, discussed in the collective volume *Complottisti vulnerabili* (2023). His publications also include *Learning Through Others* (2020) and the recent *Forme e significati della fioritura morale* (2025). His scientific interests revolve around a common thread: investigating how human beings construct meaning, interpret the minds of others, cope with vulnerability, and develop cognitive and social strategies that shape both individual life and collective experience.
