BIO AND EDUCATION

He graduated (magna cum laude) from the University of Turin in 2000, completed a post-graduate course of Italian and comparative constitutional law at the University of Siena and took his PhD in Public Law at the University of Turin in 2004. He has been licensed to practise law since 2004.

He has acquired notable academic and institutional expertise in all the branches of the administrative and public law, with particular reference to the rule of law and the judicial system.

From 2005 to 2006, he was a member of a coordination group set-up within the Italian Ministry for the Environment and the Protection of the Territory for the purposes of the implementation of the reform of the environmental law, and directly contributed to the drafting of Legislative Decree no. 152/2006 (i.e. the Italian Environmental Code). From 2007 to 2010, he was the “Responsabile dell’Area Legale” (Legal Area Manager) at the Scuola Superiore Ambiente Territorio e Management, University of Perugia (Italy). In 2012, he was an Expert of regulatory and administrative simplification at the Ministry for Health.
