CURRENT ISSUES OF RESEARCH

1. Capitalism as religion

'Capitalism as religion' is studied on the basis of a preliminary discussion of classic works of Rousseau, Meillet, Simmel, Weber, Bergson, Benjamin and contemporary scholars like Latour, Sloterdijk, Streeck, Zelizer, Balibar, Stimilli, as a new form of association of money with mith. The relationship between the new 'debt religion' and individuals, groups, cities, nations and unions of nations (like the EU) will be the main research focus.

2. The Urban Contract

Today, the increasing mobility of capital, people and information has changed the space relations of urban societies. Contractual relations have increased in every field of social life: in the economic field, but also in the political, creative and scientific areas. Contracts are not only legal frameworks or economic aggregates of individuals, but socially embedded forms. The concept of a contract city proposed in this research on Europe, North America and Asia combines the theoretical body of economic-juridical literature on the contract with that of historical-anthropological and socio-spatial literature on the city.

3. Urbanization and corridors

The Italian urban growth has been characterized during the last decades by the new form of corridors, particularly in the North of the country. The research analyzes-within the wider European and world framework of 'city-regions ' – these new forms of urban diffusion which are redesigning both the geography and the socio-economic structures of the territory.

4. Logistics and territory

Ports, inland terminals, airports, railways and highways are analyzed as nodes and networks of wider territorial constellations connecting local production systems and global markets. On the basis of former projects (like PALIO and North Projects) the research is focused on North-West of Italy (Liguria, Piedmont and Lombardy).

5. Mobile Earth

Mobile Earth (Terra mobile) is and Atlas for thinking and acting within the current, confused global transition. The research encompasses a variety of disciplinary approaches, from sociology to philosophy, from geography to law and history.
