CURRENT ISSUES OF RESEARCH

1. Lope de Vega's theater: editions and studies

Abstract –Critical editions for PROLOPE (Proyecto Lope), Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, and different studies about semiotic, hermeneutic, meta-theatrical, and stylistic aspects of Lope de Vega's production, mainly of the 'comedia de capa y espada'.

2. Agustín Moreto's theater

Abstract –Critical editions for PROTEO, Universidad de Burgos, and study of specific aspects of Moreto's theater, such as his re-writing of previous dramas, in particular those of Lope de Vega-.

3. Pérez de Montalbán's Theater

Abstract –Critical edition of *Olimpa y Vireno*, whose plot is taken from *Furioso*, and studies of literary aspects related to the influence of Ariosto in Spain

4. Baroque theater in the XXth century

Abstract –Quite all the Spanish avant-garde artists, such as Valle-Inclán, García Lorca and Max Aub, instead of reject the literary and artistic traditions, find the way of revitalizing them; the last essay about this trend concerns the relationship between dramatic space and female characters from Baroque to the beginnings of the XXth century.

5. Relationships and contaminations in XVI-XVII century theater in Italy, Spain and France

Abstract –In collaboration with other foreign colleagues, I'm developing the study of the mutual influences and relationships among the theater of Italy, Spain and France in XVI-XVII centuries, particularly the Italian-Spanish exchanges.
