## **CURRENT RESEARCH INTERESTS**

### **1. Greek tragedy: philology and interpretation**

Editions with commentaries of Greek tragedies (*Hecuba* of Euripides; Cambridge University Press 2018; *Choephoroi* of Aeschylus, in preparation for a series edited by the Accademia dei Lincei, Rome). The commentaries focus on language, metre, stagecraft, and on the literary and philological interpretation of the plays.

### **2. Greek tragedy: language, metre, structure**

I am preparing some general interpretive studies and reference works on Greek tragedy: Oxford Bibliography Online, entry “The Tragic Chorus” (with Marco Catrambone); “The language of Euripides” (in A. Markantonatos, *Brill Companion to Euripides*); papers on Pasiphae in Euripides and on Oedipus and Tiresias in Sophocles’ *Oedipus Rex*.

### **3. Greek lyric**

I am working on problems of metrical and papyrological interpretation in the field of ancient Greek lyric, with special attention to Sappho, archaic lyric, and dithyramb.

### **4. Greek language**

Some of my recent and forthcoming publications deal with the interpretation of ancient Greek language, with special attention to metaphor, pragmatic, word order, politeness theory.

## 5. Greek epic

I am planning to work on the narrative structure of the *Iliad*, in relation with the modalities of decision-making in Homer.
